Access
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Latitude/Longitude – Primary access location is Lat. 47.5048N, by Long. 94.6838W. Winter Only – All operations limited to winter, frozen ground or sufficient snow cover to protect soil surface.
Cutting and Skidding
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stumps – Average stump heights below 12" and as low as possible. Stay within Boundaries - Unless approved in advance by the Forester, all harvest activities shall be confined to within the marked boundary. Access roads, skid trails and landing areas proposed for use outside the harvest boundary must be approved prior to use.
Harvest and Reserves
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Boundary Blue Dot/Red Dot – Blue dot boundary interior, red dots near property lines Den Trees – Reserve trees with obvious den and cavity usage, even if not marked to leave. Leave Trees: White pine, white spruce, burr oak

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Landings, Access Roads, and Skid Trails

- Landings Approved – Landing locations must be approved in advance by the Forester. Sale plan includes 3 landings
- Roads stay open - Sale is mostly accessible via existing road system. Roads to remain open and in pre-existing or better condition with BMP drainage after use. Any temporary trail or spur will be closed.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

- RMZ General - Wetland and lowland brush areas are either excluded from the harvest block or protected by ERZ within block. Be sure to minimize scarification in filter strip per BMP guidelines.
- Small wetlands –there are numerous small wet areas inside, adjacent to and between harvest areas. Frozen operations only.

Slash Disposal

Lop & scatter slash

Tree Size, Marketing, and Special Conditions

- 4 inch TDIB – Utilize all material from butt to a 4” top diameter inside bark.

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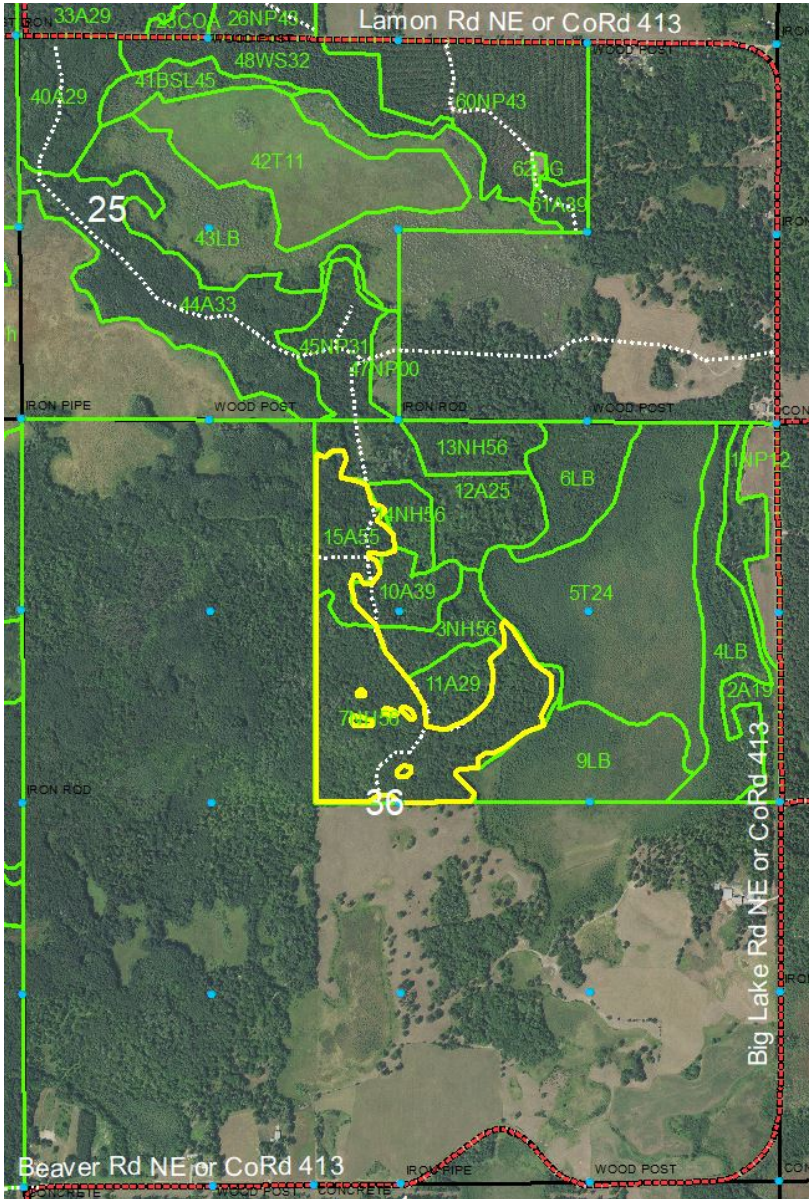
